Schedule Change Requests

If you wish to make a change to your schedule for next year, complete the [Schedule Change Request](#) form. Please complete all sections to have your counselor review the course request change for next year. We cannot guarantee that the change can be made as the number of sections offered for courses was based on original choice sheets. If you are selecting an advanced course instead of on level, review the LISD summer information page to determine if you now have a summer assignment. For a list of courses available at GHS and the course catalog, you can visit the [Academic Planning](#) section of the GHS Counseling Services website.

The deadline to request a change is Monday, August 6th at 4:00 pm.

No change requests will be accepted after August 6th. More details regarding change requests can be found in the course catalog on page 14.

Incomplete forms or submissions that are not specific will not be considered.

The Counseling Department is offering two days, August 2nd 7:30am-4:00pm and August 6th 8:00am-4:00pm, where students will have the opportunity to view their schedules prior to the **August 6th** deadline. Counselors will be available at the front of the school at the main entrance to allow students to view their tentative schedules online. We will not be offering printed copies as schedules will be tentative. We will allow pictures to be taken of tentative schedules. The purpose of the schedule viewing is to verify that the correct course level is entered (on level or advanced) and electives choices meet students' endorsement plans. Students will have the opportunity to request a change at that time.

Final schedules will be distributed to students on the first day of school.
