End of Year mLISD Summer Program Announcement: Payments for mLISD Laptops--The payment window opened April 1st for families to renew their students' district-provided laptops. If current 6th-11th graders pay by May 20th, they will be able to keep their laptops over the summer. Current 5th graders may also pay in advance to prepare for the deployment of their laptops, which will occur at the beginning of the next school year. Price: \$70 for entire year or \$35 reduced rate for students who qualify. NOTE: Scholarship students must reapply each year.
